

Thank you for your interest in attending our equestrian summer day camp! Serenity Show Stables is a hunter/jumper facility located in Miami FI and offers year-round lesson programs to all levels of riders young and grown.

Summer Camp is a day camp where campers will acquire a unique learning experience that extends past simply learning to ride but enjoy all aspects of horsemanship in a safe, fun, friendly environment and that will build memories that last a lifetime.

Camp includes: Daily horseback riding instruction, camp games on both the horse as well as on foot, barn maintenance and management, arts & crafts, movies, and horse care & education. Open to children ages 7-13 at the. No riding experience is necessary!

Registration Process

Please read the following carefully. Summer Camp enrollment is first come, first served. To register please complete the Summer Camp Registration Form and submit with payment. Payment methods include Venmo, Zelle or Personal Check made out to Serenity Show Stables.

Early Registration (April 7- May 20

- Individual week \$400
- Package of 3 consecutive weeks \$1100
- For all camp sessions \$2450 (7 weeks @ \$350/week)

Registration Fees (after May 20)

- Individual week \$450
- Package of 3 consecutive weeks \$1200
- For all camp sessions \$2625 (7 weeks @ \$375/week)

We do offer sibling discounts. Please inquire if you intend to enroll multiple children.

When to show up

Camp runs Monday-Friday, 9:00am - 3:00pm.

Before and after care is available at an additional charge of \$20.00 per 30 minutes and be pre-arranged. Please contact Serenity Show Stables, prior to the starting of the camp week to make arrangements for before/after care.

What to bring

Camp provides all the necessary horseback riding equipment.

Campers must bring:

- Lunch Monday Friday
- Sufficient hydration (water, Gatorade, etc.)
- Afternoon snack
- Breeches, Jeans or leggings. No sweat pants.
- Extra change of clothing (shorts, sun shirts, and attire for water games)
- Close-toed shoes or riding boots
- Sunscreen
- Hat / Sunglasses

Serenity Show Stables does not allow campers to have any form of electronics during activities such as: riding, or participating in the other pre-planned group activities including such as water games, arts and crafts or other games. Serenity Show Stables well understand that most campers do have phones, tablets, etc. and will not prohibit them from bringing them for the safety of all campers, we do ask that parents explain to their child/ children that any apps that contain live Geo-tracking must be disabled during camp hours. No live streaming of any activities is allowed by any campers. Serenity Show Stables instructors frequently take pictures and videos that can be sent upon request by parent. Please note that if you choose to bring personal electronic devices or any other personal items, Serenity Show Stables is not responsible for items lost, stolen, or damaged.

Serenity Show Stables has a strict No-Bullying policy, any camper found bullying on premises or online will be asked to leave immediately with no refund

Serenity Show Stables Rules and Regulations

1) All riders MUST wear ASTM/SEI Certified helmets while mounted.

2) Riders may not be on top of a horse inside or around the barn area or on the wash racks.

3) Keep all common areas (wash racks, breezeway, bathrooms, etc.) clean and free of debris at all times. Keep areas in front of stalls picked up and organized. Campers are expected to clean up after themselves.

4) Parents dropping off children must provide Serenity Show Stables with a copy of their medical insurance card and signed consent allowing instructors to act as guardians in the event of an accident where medical attention is required and the parent cannot be reached.

5) Social media posts are welcomed and encouraged; however, any audio clips where trainers can be heard giving instruction must be removed. Any person found posting on social media or in group chats negative or derogatory comments towards ANY other rider will be immediately asked to leave. "SSS " has a ZERO tolerance policy in regards to bullying of any kind.
